Expression of Interest (EOI) for preliminary survey for SAMARTH (*Scheme for Capacity Building in Textile Sector*) Scheme

National Handloom Development Corporation Limited (NHDC) invites **Expression of Interest (EOI)** from its **empanelled Mobilization & Facilitation Partners (MFPs)** for conducting a **baseline survey** to assess the feasibility of implementing Skill Development Training Programmes under the **SAMARTH Scheme (Scheme for Capacity Building in Textile Sector)** of the Ministry of Textiles, Government of India.

The baseline survey will facilitate identification of suitable locations, training infrastructure, trainers, and potential beneficiaries for preparation of project proposals to be submitted under the SAMARTH Scheme.

Scope of Baseline Survey

The survey shall broadly include, but not be limited to, the following:

1. Identification of potential candidates/beneficiaries willing to undergo skill development training in the textile and handloom sector.
2. Preparation of a verified district-wise database of prospective candidates.
3. Assessment of demand for approved job roles under the SAMARTH Scheme.
4. Identification of suitable training infrastructure including Government Institutions, Educational Institutions, Common Facility Centres (CFCs), NGOs, Handloom Service Centres, Training Institutes and other eligible premises.
5. Assessment of availability of qualified trainers possessing the prescribed educational qualifications and valid Training of Trainers (ToT) certification, wherever applicable.
6. Identification of local industries, handloom units, apparel manufacturers, exporters, producer companies, Self Help Groups (SHGs), cooperative societies and other establishments for placement and apprenticeship opportunities.
7. Assessment of residential/hostel facilities wherever residential training is proposed.
8. Identification of artisan clusters, handloom societies, cooperative societies and traditional craft clusters suitable for implementation of the programme.

9. Collection of recommendations and support, wherever feasible, from:

- District Administration / Local Authorities

10. Assessment of overall readiness of the proposed training location for successful implementation of the programme.
